The directorate's mission is to deliver responsive space capabilities to users across the National Security Space community and conduct developmental planning, science & technology, and pre-systems acquisition for the Space & Missile Systems Center. Colonel Sejba leads a combined team of 740+ military, government civilians, and contractors in four geographically separated units responsible for development, acquisition, demonstration, launch, test and operations of DOD and civil space systems.

Colonel Sejba is also serving as the Acting Director for Space Rapid Capabilities Office (SpRCO) Kirtland AFB, NM. In this role Colonel Sejba oversees the development, demonstration, and fielding of space capabilities focused on timely satisfaction of Joint Force Commanders' needs.
