#### 1) What is GPSPC?

**A:** The GPS Partnership Council is the single, annual, gathering of all stakeholders for the total GPS Enterprise. This is the one place where all stakeholders can discuss issues affecting the entire Global Positioning System with subject-matter experts from across the GPS Enterprise.
